

### **Home Improvement** Projects

Wash brushes and other equipment in indoor sinks whenever possible.

**Properly dispose of home** improvement waste.

Keep materials and equipment in covered areas, protected from rain and wind.



## **Runoff Reduction**

Install rain barrels to capture and reuse rain water on your property. **Channel water from** downspouts and gutters to stable land-scaped areas.

Consider installing a rain garden, using sustainable landscape and native plants.

### Pets

Always pick up after pets. **Properly dispose** of pet waste in the trash. Don't forget a leash and pet waste bags when going on a **Pool, Spa and Fountain Maintenance** 

Be sure that water is pHneutral with no chlorine before draining to the street and storm drain.

Do not backflush filters to the street or storm drain.

### **Sediment and Erosion Control**

Use mulch, silt fence, and/or straw wattles to prevent dirt from washing off your property, especially on slopes.

Use plants, grass, rock, gravel or mulch as long-term solutions to erosion.

### Landscaping

**Use lawn chemicals** sparingly and follow the manufacturers directions. Do not over apply.

Have your soil tested before applying fertilizer.

**Choose Indiana-friendly and** native plants.



### **General Housekeeping** Sweep up outdoor areas, instead of hosing them down.

Place landscaping debris, leaves and sticks away from drains.

Consider all outdoor drains as storm drains, and do not dump or wash to them.



**Properly contain spills** and automotive fluids. Clean up spills using dry methods only.

Keep auto parts and exposed engines protected from the rain.





### **Car Washing**

Wash your car at a commercial car wash if possible, where wash water is recycled or discharged to sanitary sewer.

If you wash your car at home, park it off the street and on grass or gravel if possible.

Use a hose with a shut-off nozzle, or fill a bucket with soapy water. Use soap sparingly.
